Оборудование: персональный компьютер.

Тема урока: “We Want to Be Famous Too”.

Цель урока: Развитие навыков говорения (диалогическая, монологическая речь).

Задачи урока: Развитие навыков лексики. Узнать и попытаться использовать незнакомую лексику при дискуссии и монологической речи.

Воспитательные цели: Развитие культуры общения и познавательного интереса.

<i>Учитель английского языка:</i>	– Good-afternoon, children. I am glad to see you. Today we take a look at Charlie Chaplin. What do you know about Charlie Chaplin?	- He is a famous actor. - He played in black - and-white movie.
<i>Учитель начинает показ презентации</i>	- Very well. Let’s get to know him better. <i>Слайд №1</i>	Читают и переводят информацию со слайдов презентации.
<i>После показа презентации учитель обращает внимание на Слайд №12</i>	- Now, please pay attention to the speech that said Charlie Chaplin on his seventieth birthday - What do you think, What he wanted to say the most important thing in his speech? - You are right, but the most important that he had lived a hard life and knew how to be happy.	- He wanted to tell how to be a wise - He told how to love each other.
<i>Учитель обращает внимание на Слайд №13</i>	-Please, look at the some interesting facts from the life of Charlie Chaplin. What do you think what kind of man he was?	- He was a wise man. - He was very a hard-working person. - He was a person with a sense of humor.
